Worms is among the three oldest cities in Germany and was founded by Romans. There are so many beautiful sites for us to discover and much history to learn! Our morning begins bright and early with a European breakfast sandwich and mimosa or juice on a coach bus from Panzer Kaserne (Exchange Parking Lot) to Worms. First we will take an English guided walking tour which will include the Jewish cemetery-the oldest in Europe, the Reformation Monument which is a group of statues dedicated to Martin Luther and the largest in the world and finally the Imperial Cathedral of Worms (St. Peter's Dom) a Romanesque Cathedral built in the 11th and 12th centuries. Lunch will be "on your own" so that you may linger over a relaxed pace meal or choose a quick bite with time to shop or explore instead! Finally, we will get on the bus and stop at Winery Boxheimerhof for a wine tasting of 6 wines with cheese before making our way back to Panzer. We expect to return to Panzer Kaserne at approximately 8:00 PM.
